

Admission requirements

The issue of automatically inserting standard admission statements into the UTS: Handbook (and elsewhere) against each course was discussed at the Associate Deans meeting on 24 August 2010.

At that meeting it was agreed that there was value in including the statements, but for clarity, the wording 'UTS: Rule' be inserted before the admission requirements statement and the standard eligibility statement be moved to below the three CIS fields and ELR statement. Faculties can add data to the three CIS fields to clarify the UTS rule (if required) and this clarification should be displayed directly below the rule, i.e.:

Admission requirements

UTS Rule (admission requirements based on course qualification level)

CIS: Admission requirements: all

CIS: Admission requirements: local

CIS: Admission requirements: international

ELR statement (based on CASS data)

Eligibility statement (standard statement)

Visa requirements statement (standard statement)

Admission requirements based on course qualification level (UTS Rule)

There are five distinct admission requirement statements based on a course's qualification level. The data for each statement is stored centrally in CIS. The applicable statement is mapped to the course's qualification level held in CASS and used for display in the UTS: Handbook and anywhere else that displays admission requirement data.

MC MCC GDN GDE GC	Master's Coursework Master's Combined Coursework Grad Dip New Area of Study Grad Dip Extending Previous Area of Study Graduate Certificate	UTS Rule: Applicants must have completed a recognised Australian bachelor's degree in a related field of study, or an equivalent or higher qualification, or submitted other evidence of general and professional qualifications that demonstrates potential to pursue graduate studies.
BG BH	Bachelor's Graduate Entry Bachelor's Honours	UTS Rule: Applicants must have completed a recognised Australian bachelor's degree in a relevant discipline at an appropriate level.
BD BCD	Bachelor's Degree Bachelor's Combined Degree	UTS Rule: Applicants must have completed an Australian Year 12 qualification, Australian Qualifications Framework Diploma, or equivalent Australian or overseas qualification at the required level.

English language requirements (ELR) statement

There are currently seven English language requirements sets. The data for each set is stored centrally in CIS. Courses have an ELR set number assigned to them in CASS, as required. This number is mapped to the relevant data set in CIS and used for display in the UTS: Handbook and anywhere else that displays admission requirement data, e.g. International prospectuses, UTSI website, etc.

ELR 1

Academic IELTS: 7.0 overall with a writing score of 7.0; or TOEFL: paper based: 600 overall with TWE of 5.0, internet based: 100 overall with a writing score of 23; or DEEP: A

ELR 2

Academic IELTS: 7.0 overall with a writing score of 7.0; or TOEFL: paper based: 600 overall with TWE of 5.0, internet based: 100 overall with a writing score of 23; or DEEP: B+

ELR 3

Academic IELTS: 6.5 overall with a writing score of 6.0; or TOEFL: paper based: 575 overall with TWE of 4.5, internet based: 90 overall with a writing score of 21; or DEEP: B

ELR 4

Academic IELTS: 6.0 overall with a writing score of 6.0; or TOEFL: paper based: 550 overall with TWE of 4.5, internet based: 80 overall with a writing score of 21; or DEEP: C

ELR 5

Academic IELTS: 6.5 overall with a writing score of 6.0; or TOEFL: paper based: 575 overall with TWE of 4.5, internet based: 90 overall with a writing score of 21; or DEEP: C

ELR 6

Academic IELTS: 5.0-6.0 overall with a writing score of 5.0; or TOEFL: paper based: 510-550 overall with TWE of 3.0, internet based: 64-80 overall with a writing score of 17

ELR 7 BTeach

Academic IELTS: 7.5 overall, with a minimum of 8.0 in both the speaking and listening modules, and a reading and writing score of 7.0; or TOEFL: paper based: 623 overall with TWE of 5.0, internet based: 106 overall with a writing score of 24; or DEEP: A. The English language requirements for the LOTE major are: Academic IELTS: 6.5 overall with a writing score of 6.0; or TOEFL: paper based: 575 overall with TWE of 4.5, internet based: 90 overall with a writing score of 21; or DEEP: B

Eligibility statement

There is one eligibility statement. The data is stored centrally in CIS. It is displayed in the UTS: Handbook and anywhere else that displays admission requirement data. It appears below the UTS Rule statement, CIS field data (if any) and ELR statement.

ADM ELG

Eligibility for admission does not guarantee offer of a place.

Visa requirements statement

There is one visa requirements statement. The data is stored centrally in CIS. If a course has a liability category for international students in CASS, the Visa requirements statement is displayed in the UTS: Handbook and anywhere else that displays admission requirement data.

VR INT

To obtain a student visa to study in Australia, international students must enrol full time and on campus. Australian student visa regulations also require international students studying on student visas to complete the course within the standard full-time duration. Students can extend their courses only in exceptional circumstances.
